We are seeking a part time Children, Youth & Families Worker to work in the churches and communities of the Settle Methodist Circuit.

Settle Methodist Circuit is a lively, faith-centred community of six churches situated on the edge of the Yorkshire Dales National Park. We're looking for someone passionate about sharing God's love with children, young people and families. The ideal applicant will bring warmth, creativity, and a welcoming spirit – helping others feel valued and included. Experience of working or volunteering with these age groups is essential, along with a heart for outreach and a desire to nurture faith in everyday life.

This is an exciting new post, complementing the work of our existing Circuit Mission Enablers, and the person appointed will support and develop existing provision for children, young people and families so that they may hear and respond to the Christian Gospel and grow spiritually. They will help our churches to discover and develop new ways of working with children in their communities.

The appointment will be subject to an enhanced DBS Disclosure with barred list check and an occupational requirement exists for the post-holder to be a practising Christian.

NEXT STEPS & MAIN TERMS

Hours of work:	An average of 20 hours per week, the average being calculated on a four-weekly basis, worked flexibly in agreement with your Line Manager. Actual days, start and finish times will be variable in accordance with the needs of the Employer. The days of the week on which you may be required to work are Monday to Sunday, with some evening working in agreement with your Line Manager. You will not be expected to work on more than five days in a calendar week. You should be able to attend evening meetings as required (approximately three per annum).
Contract:	2 Years Fixed Term Contract (with the possibility of extension subject to review and funding)
Rate of pay:	£14.65 per hour with enrolment in the Circuit's workplace pension scheme.
Location:	Home based if the candidate lives within or close to the Circuit (an office base is available if preferred). However, regular engagement and attendance in the Circuit's churches and communities will be key to the success of this role.
