



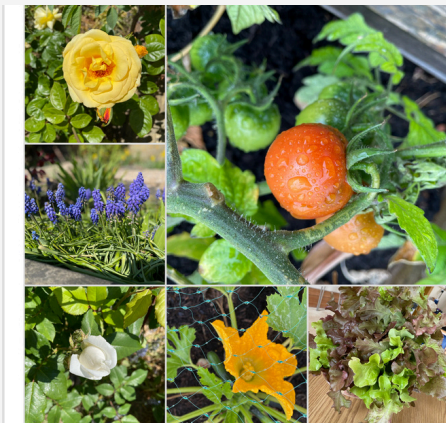

NEW TOILETS

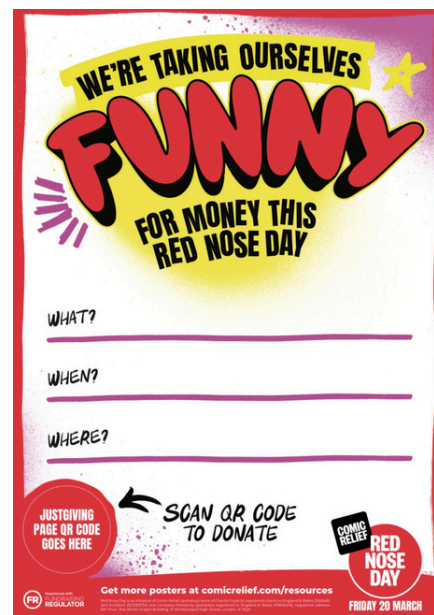
Bad News: We were closed for the first 2 weeks of the year

Good news: This was to refresh and renew our toilet facilities. We now have a nice sparkly toilet.

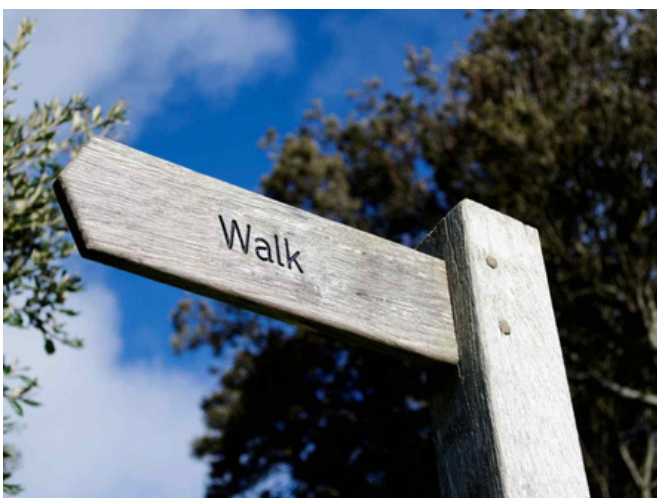
COMIC RELIEF
